1 Why MusiBee4?

MusiBee4 gives songwriters a professional place to present songs to singers, artists, producers and potential buyers without simply throwing everything into the open. You get your own publishing space, called your Hive, with your own shareable URL.



2 What you get

- A private Hive with your own shareable URL
- Professional song pages and enquiry routes
- Clear licence options for each song
- Proof of Publishing records and version history
- Locked song versions so buyers licence exactly what you offered
- A stronger evidence trail showing what existed, and when



3 How it helps protect your work

MusiBee4 helps record important details about your song, including the creator, title, files, lyrics version and publishing record. It can also create digital file fingerprints and version history, helping show that a particular version of your work existed at a particular time.

4 Exclusive or non-exclusive?



Non-exclusive

If you offer a non-exclusive licence, your song can usually remain available elsewhere.



Exclusive rights

If an artist wants exclusive rights, you may need to remove the song from other platforms.



5 Version lock

On MusiBee4, buyers can only licence the version you have locked in. If you later change the lyrics, demo or song details, the updated work can receive a new Proof of Publishing certificate.



6 Important to know

MusiBee4 promotes the platform, not you personally. Your Hive is your own professional space, but its success depends on how much you share it, invite people to it, and promote it commercially and personally.



7 Founding Creator offer

Founding Creators currently get up to 30 songs, a free Proof of Publishing licence for each published song, and the benefits of the Pro Plan for free during the founding stage.
